What is ATPH?

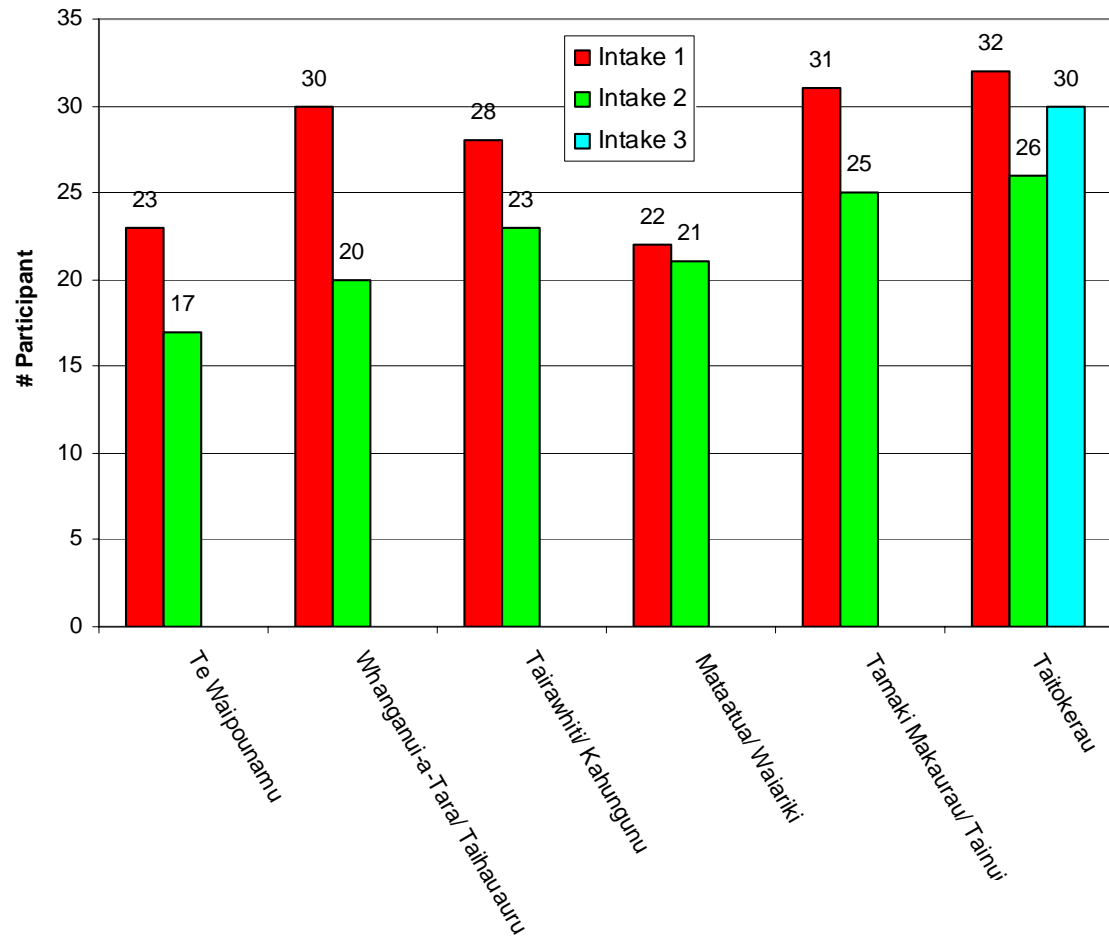
- A specialised programme delivered by Māori, to Māori
- Uses the context of wānanga and weaves the principles of adult learning with the real life practical application of tīkanga and values Māori
- Reinforces the importance of child-centred and strengths-based practices





To date, we have completed the delivery of 13 training intakes through the provision of wānanga

What do we do?

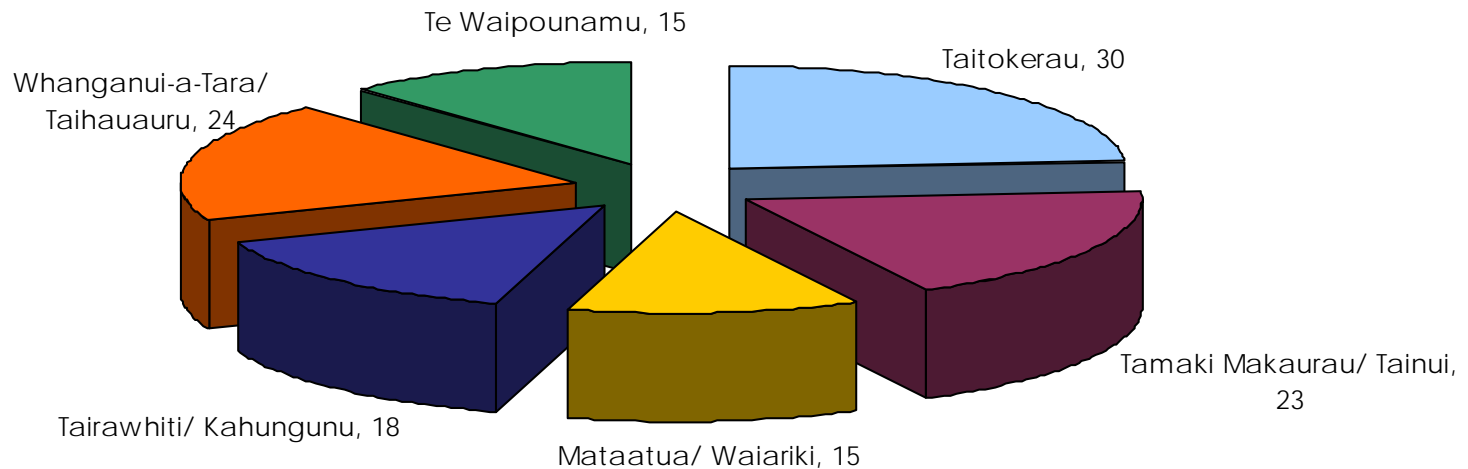
- We provide an environmental context for providers to experience first hand the learning, then enable them to take this to the whānau they work with
- The goal is to contribute tools and value to the programmes of providers so that whānau receive the most effective support they require

Who are we?



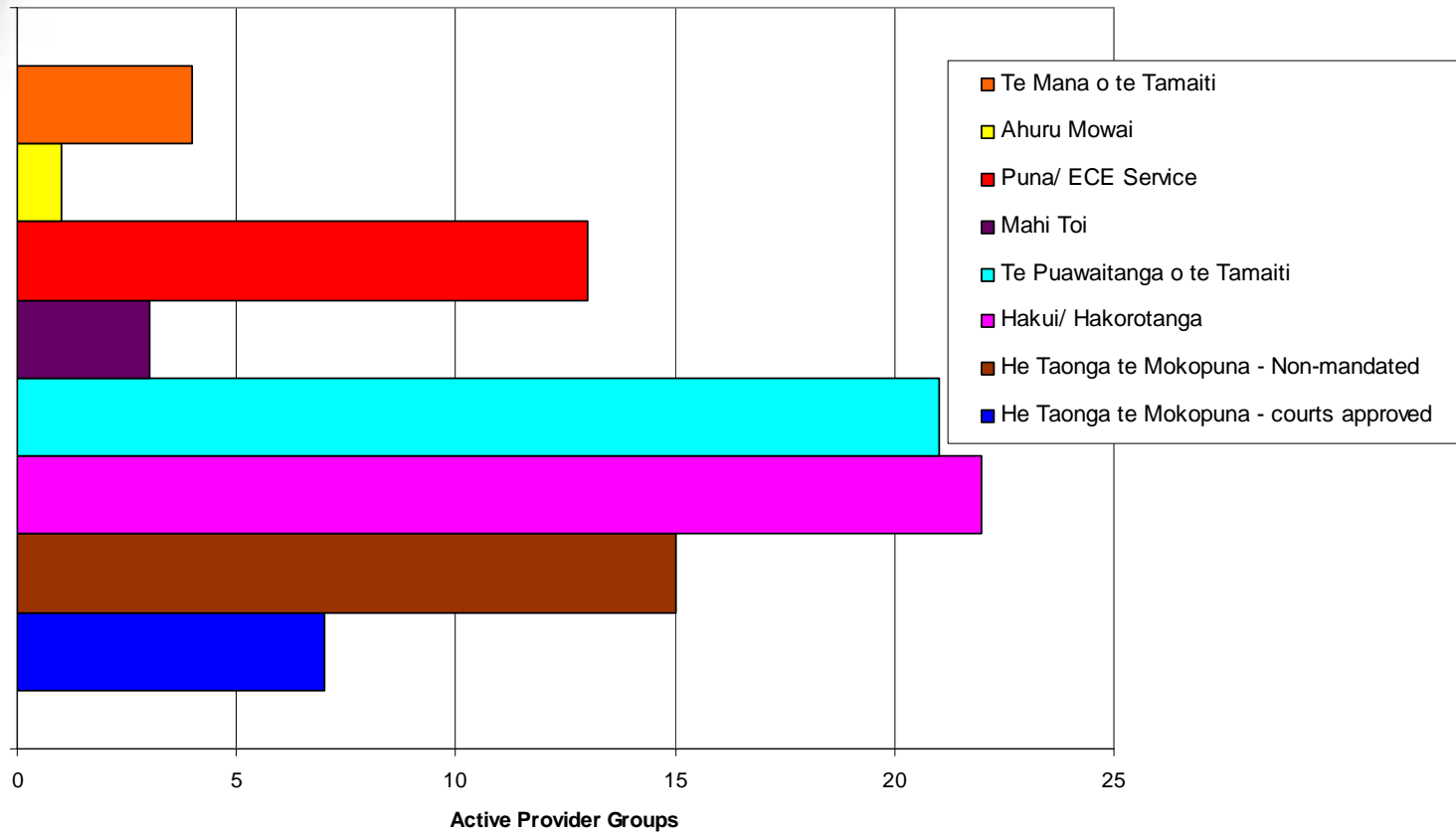
- The Te Kōmako Team are committed to providing high quality training, mentoring and support
