- Followed by 2 further CAMHAS national conferences

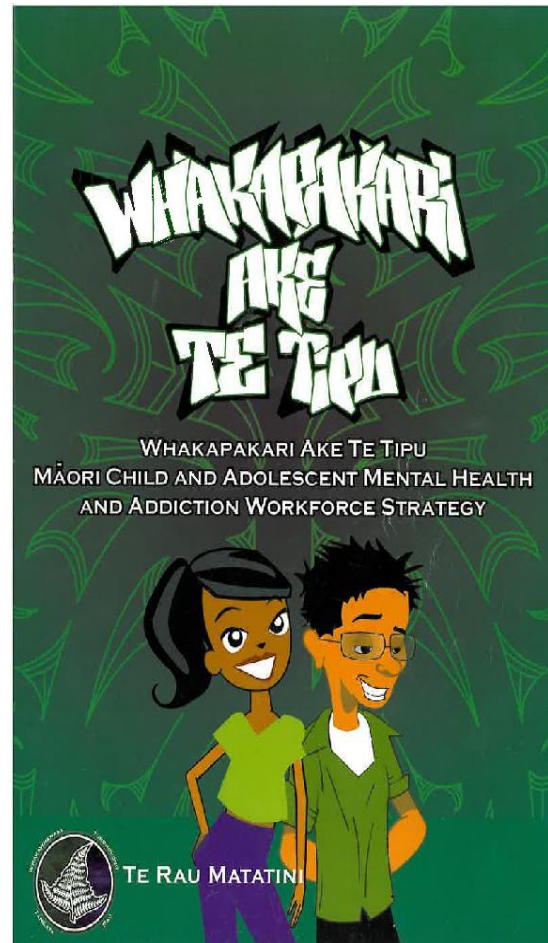


Te Rau Tipu

Strategic Leadership Roopu

- Started as a network group in 2003 - made up of members from Māori CAMHAS in DHBs and NGOs both North and South Island
- Whakapakari Ake Te Tipu (2007) - Māori Child and Adolescent Mental Health and Addiction Workforce Strategy.
- Identifies key Māori child and adolescent mental health and addiction workforce priorities.

Strategies

- Pathway Tuatahi: Tangata Whaiora and whānau Participation
- Pathway Tuarua: whānau, Hāpu, Iwi and Māori Community Development
- Pathway Tuatoru: Education and Training Development



Strategies (cont'd)

- Pathway Tuawha: Dedicated Māori Mental Health Workforce
- Pathway Tuarima: Primary Care in Mental Health
- Pathway Tuaono: Wider Sectoral Workforce Development



Strategies (cont'd)

- Pathway Tuawhitu: Mental Health Promotion
- Pathway Tuawaru: Planning for the Future Māori Mental Health Workforce

Progress To Date

- Te Rau Tipu have progressively work shopped 6 of the 8 strategies at the quarterly meetings.
- Remaining strategies to be completed by December 2009.
- **Purpose:** To find out from members about the workforce activities and initiatives that are going on in their rohe (geographical area) – that relate to the strategies
- Explore activities and initiatives that can be highlighted as transferrable models or examples.
- Updated analysis of and findings from workshops.





Outcome from Strategies to Date

- Add a rangatahi leadership focus group to Te Rau Tipu membership – work in progress.
- Update Te Rau Tipu website - work in progress.
- Guidelines booklet using Māori models, for setting up rangatahi advisory group for Māori Child and Adolescent services – work in progress.
- Work-based placements to Māori Child and Adolescent services
